The document ends with the following: "Beyond your visit: --If you feel ill, please seek testing. Testing site locations are available at <https://coronavirus.health.ny.gov/find-test-site-near-you--> If you test positive, please mention your [Library Name] visit to the contact tracer. That way the contact tracer can follow through with us for staff safety and still maintain your privacy."
