- Spanish-language multimedia entertainment
 - One ticket per view: Movies, Performing arts
 - Unlimited viewing: Music, Series, TV channels, Podcasts, Games
- Patrons have 10 tickets per month
- Focus by country of origin or age audiences
- Watch on their app or Chromecast

The Shelf Access and Marketing

- The Shelf use the *Iniciar secion* link to sign in or sign up
- Use the dropdown in the top right corner to select a language.
- The Shelf Live Free access to Spanish-language courses, interviews, film clubs, book clubs. The Shelf Live events are available at the time of the event for anyone logged in with their card. For example, once a month The Shelf Live has "Noche de Palomitas" (Popcorn night).

The Shelf Public Performance Rights

Almost all recorded titles can be used in a public exhibition at the library.

- At least 14 days before the showing, open a help desk ticket or email support@wlsmail.org to Allison Midgley's attention. Place a request for prior authorization for a film in their catalog. Include the film title, its URL, and the date that you want to show it. Allison will contact The Shelf representative to get authorization.
- They will create a The Shelf Live event. You can share the link with patrons ahead of time and broadcast the session in the library at the time of the event.
- Any user logged into The Shelf can access The Shelf Live events in the LIVE section of the platform. They do not request library card authentication to access any The Shelf Live online events. The online events at The Shelf Live are open and free to the audience at the library and to those whom you share the link with.


